What is the Oshawa Walk of Fame?

Our wonderful City of Oshawa has been home to many influential and distinguished Canadians. The Oshawa Walk of Fame, established in 2006, is a non-profit organization which aims to honour Oshawans - past and present - who have made significant contributions to life in the city. This is achieved through a series of plaques set in the sidewalks along King Street in Oshawa's downtown.

In 2016 the Oshawa Rotary Club assumed responsibility for the Oshawa Walk of Fame and held a Gala Dinner and Induction Ceremony at the Jubilee Pavilion. After a COVID hiatus, this annual event returned on November 9th, 2023. Nominations are now open for 2024. The 2024 dinner will be held in November, 2024. All proceeds after expenses will be donated to local organizations by the Oshawa Rotary Club Charitable Fund.

The mission of the Oshawa Walk of Fame is to preserve, celebrate and showcase the history and heritage of excellence and achievement in Oshawa. It's important to acknowledge the achievements and successes of individuals, groups or sentient beings who have made significant contributions to life in Oshawa and honour the past to inspire the future.

Nomination Criteria

- ✓ All nominations shall reflect upon the character of the person(s), group or sentient being and the contributions they have made to life in the city of Oshawa.
- ✓ Nominee's must have been born in Oshawa or spent some of their formative/creative years here. Their accomplishments must have had an impact or brought recognition to the city in one or more of the following areas:
 - Arts & Entertainment
 - Business
 - Heritage
 - Sports
 - Politics
 - Education
 - Research
 - Media
 - Volunteerism
 - Community Builders
 - Other _____
- ✓ Nominee must have made a significant contribution in their field
- ✓ Nominee must have a minimum of 10 years experience in their area of recognition
- ✓ Nominee has gained provincial, national, or international recognition in their area of recognition

As stated above, all nominations shall reflect upon the character of the person(s), group or sentient being and their contributions to life in the city of Oshawa. Upon nomination submission, the nominator must include the **nomination form** on the following page, **a letter** listing the details of the nominee's contribution and why they deserve the award, and any **accompanying documents** (examples include articles from papers, magazines, or websites).
